At sixteen he directed a short documentary unveiling his personal experiences with teen pregnancy.

Winning state, national, and international awards, "Pointless Choices" aired nationwide on ABC-TV as part of a show hosted by Kirk Cameron. Exploring his talents outside of directing actors, he directed photography on one of the first DV features entitled "Sacrifices" in 1997.
